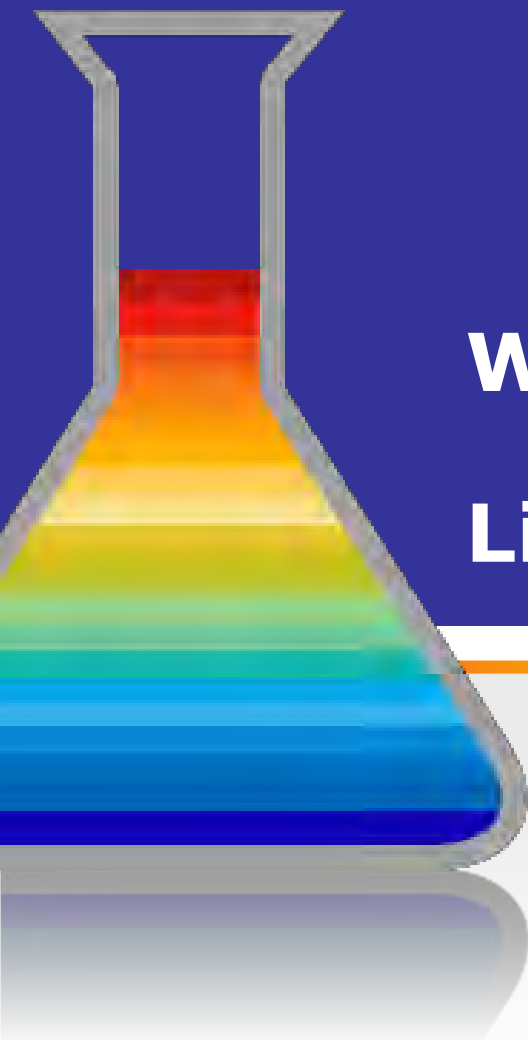

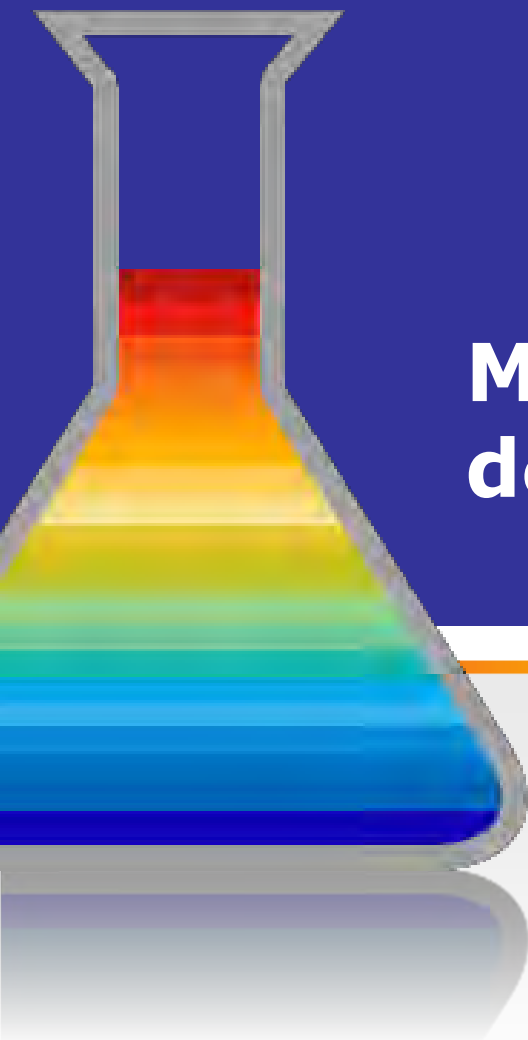

Stage 1

- Make everything in Alma, Primo and Primo Central accessible as a URI
- Return well documented JSON, preferably JSON-LD
- Describe openly and formerly at [github/ExLibrisGroup](https://github.com/ExLibrisGroup)
- All internal references should use URIs

- Already happening as we speak

Stage 2

- Extend so that includes out-going URIs
 - Authorities
 - Wikipedia
 - GeoName
 - Etc,
- Currently in research phase

Stage 2

- Our own products should use the URIs
 - This is already part of internal design paradigms
- Support end-to-end LD flows starting with Alma and ending in
- Enable integration of external resources using LD natively into our products user interfaces
